



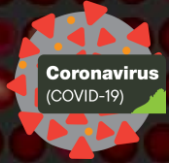

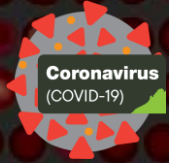
What is COVID-19 (coronavirus)?

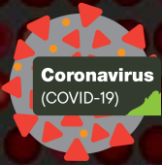
What does coronavirus mean to me?

- Please stay near the hospital and the dialysis centre in town and don't go bush



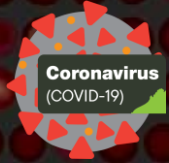
What about my dialysis?

- Share cups or cigarettes with anyone



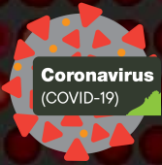
USE CAUTION

Mythbusting COVID-19

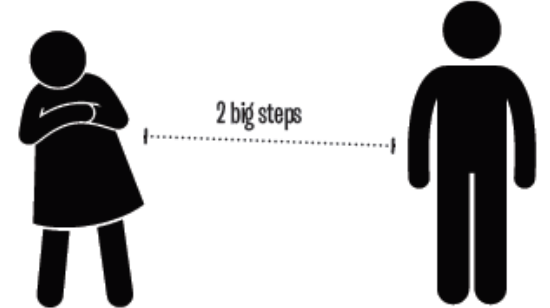
